OPENING FIELD DAY**

A special welcome was extended to the ladies of Black Rock and Indian Pond Country Clubs who participated in the tournament today.

Mary thanked Anne Adrien and Marijke Alsbach, on behalf of the League, for organizing today's tournament. She also thanked Steve Mann and his staff at Wollaston as well as the dining staff for hosting this event for us.

**Old Business**

A motion to waive reading the Secretary's report from Closing Field Day on September 5, 2006 at Wollaston Golf Club was accepted and the minutes were approved as written.

Sandy Allan presented the Treasurer's report. Opening balance on January 1, 2007 was \$1868.01. Income has been \$3006.87. Expenses total \$1275.58 leaving a balance on June 14, 2007, prior to today's expenses, of \$1731.29. Sandy noted that she was very pleased with Clubs timely response to paying annual dues and website startup assessments and reminded everyone to redeem their prize chits by November 1, 2007. The treasurer's report was accepted as written.

There was no other old business.

**New Business**

Mary reviewed several key items aimed at revitalizing the WSSGL that she first presented at Closing Day 2006. Over the winter the WSSGL website has been implemented. It contains nearly all the information previously contained in the "Pink Book" as well as sections for team standings and current events of interest to League members. Work is continuing on the Directory section so that privacy issues can be

properly addressed. All members are encouraged to use the site located at [www.wssgl.com](http://www.wssgl.com).

The season schedule has been changed so that all play takes place between Memorial Day and Labor Day. The format for Opening Day has been changed to a Bramble format. Plans to expand the League are moving forward and we are in discussion with the ladies chairs, pros and owners at Black Rock and Indian Pond Country Clubs. Ladies from both clubs have been invited to participate in most of our 2007 summer "special" tournaments. In order to further help us get to know each other, Black Rock hosted an invitational in May and Indian Pond will host an invitational on September 11. Details of the tournament will be sent to ladies chairs later this summer. Currently the proposal for expansion would include Indian Pond and Black Rock as a combined team since neither club feels it could support a full team on their own. There is precedent for doing this, but since it not a usual event for us Mary anticipates asking for a vote at Closing Field Day in August. League members would are not in attendance may vote by proxy at each club and mail ballots to the League secretary.

Mary stressed once again that we will need to fill several Board positions which expire at the end of the season. She encouraged everyone to consider volunteering their time to help make the League run smoothly.

Mary once again encouraged all members to visit the website as it is continually being updated. Boros entries are due one week before the tournament. Please note the following team match starting time changes: Halifax – all matches start at 8:30, Marshfield matches will have starting times this season.

There being no other new business Mary thanked everyone once again for participating in today's tournament and noted that there were 95 participants-an increase from last year. Meeting was adjourned at 2:30 PM and Mary introduced Anne Dillon and Barbara Chandler to present today's winners.
