Old Business

Kathy Moody was unavailable tonight to review the tournament report. She will be reviewing all of the year's tournaments and will report back at our next board meeting. Carol Neuger reminded all tournament chairs that entries for all tournaments (along with GHIN number) need to be in one week prior to the tournament.

New Business

Beth Nightingale distributed a working copy of next year's schedule for tournaments and team matches. The schedule was reviewed and several changes will be made due to conflicts at various clubs. All chairpersons will review and request specific dates from their club and will get in touch with Beth regarding any conflicts or changes.

Gini Johnson asked for clarification of rules for team matches when players arrive late to the match. The answer was not given at this time since Beth has appointed Denise Royer to chair a group that will review all of the current team rules. She will come up with some changes that will be presented for discussion at the January meeting.

Carol Neuger thanked the group for timely entries for the tournaments. Several suggestions were made regarding tournaments in an effort to facilitate smooth transition from play to lunch and prizes in order to conclude the day in a timely fashion.

Susan Enos asked about the ruling regarding which available players should play in team matches. At the present time some clubs take the lowest handicap players available and others take those who are their "regular" players over those who might sign up for just one or two matches over the course of the season. It was pointed out that at this time, the 14 lowest handicap available players are the only ones who should be playing as stated in the Team Match Rule #3.. There was much discussion and it appears that each club has a different method of selecting players each week. This also will be discussed further when the rules for team are reviewed.

Beth appointed Diane Fardy to chair the Nominating Committee for the year 2010.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:15 pm. The winter board meeting is tentatively scheduled for Jan 8, 2009.
